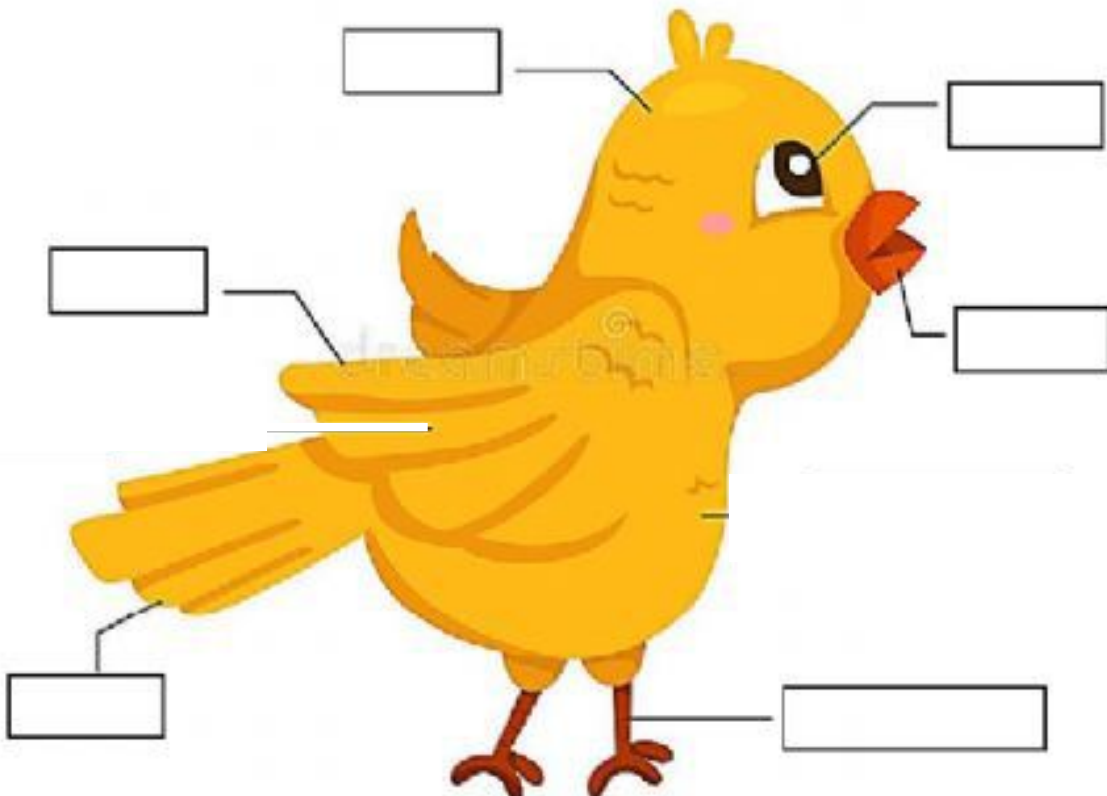
- ★ Visit the zoo and observe different animals and birds, select any 3 animals / birds of your choice, paste their pictures and write about them on A4 size sheet like:-

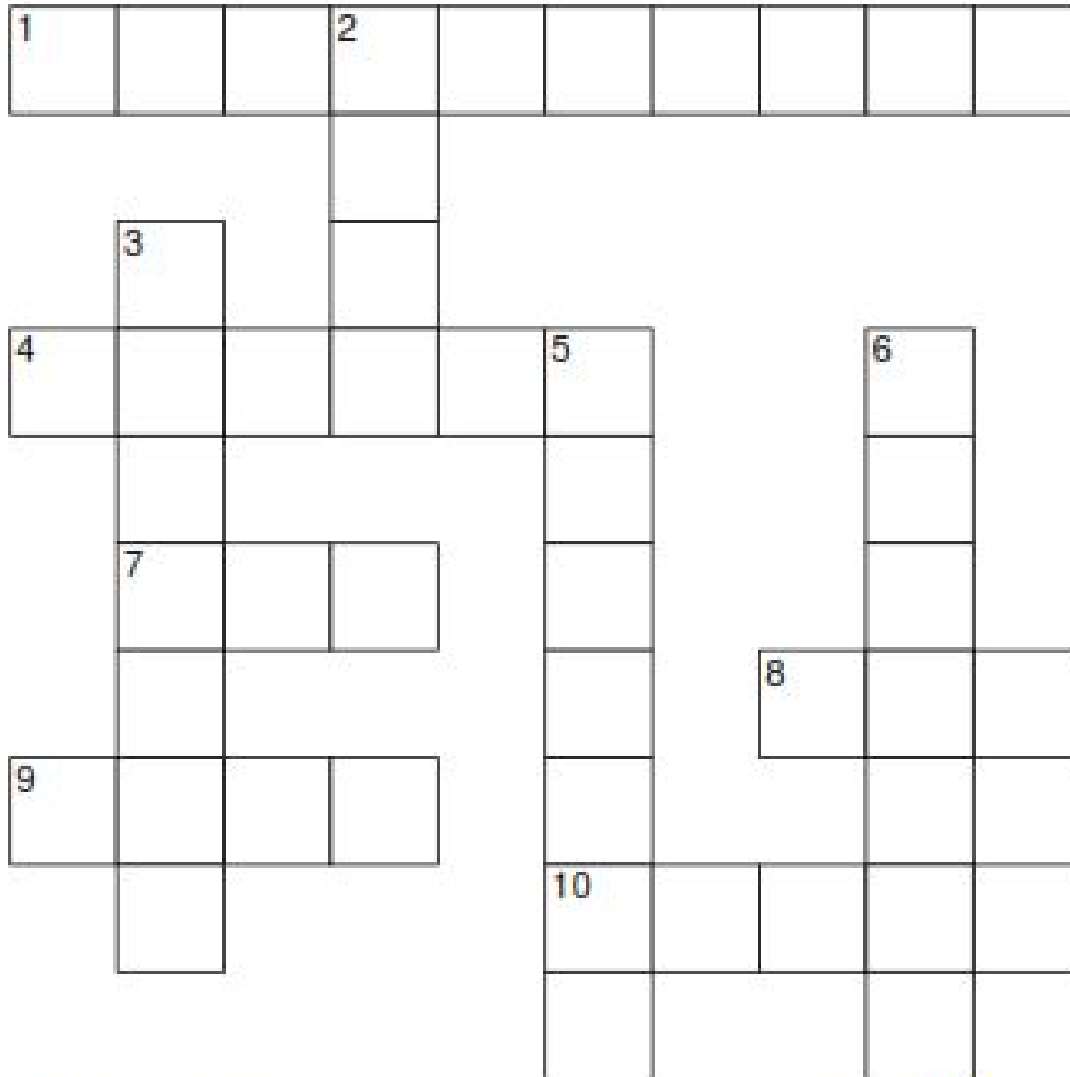
