

Albatross

- <u>African Grey Parrot</u> One of the most intelligent parrots, they can mimic any other animals and can understand the meaning of almost all words.
- Flamingos They are bright pink feathered bird and get their body colour from the food they eat. Flamingos nest's are made of mud.
 - Albatross They are sea bird mostly found in the southern hemisphere. These birds have the longest wingspan amongst the birds which is almost 12 feet.
 - The Swifts They are one of the fastest flying bird, which can sleep, eat, bath while Swifts flying. Swifts rarely touch the ground.
