- **Aurora**—It is also known as the northern or southern lights, a spectacular display of green, purple, blue and red lights that dance across the sky.
- **Bioluminescence** – It is the emission of light by living organism such as bacteria, fungi, algae, fish and insects. This can be seen in various places around the world like of glowing waves of Maldives, the blue fireflies of noon mushroom of Brazil, Japan.
- **Rainbow Mountain** – These mountains have multicolored stripes or patterns on their slopes creating a stunning visual effect and they are found in different parts of the world such as China, Peru, Iran and Argentina.
